days or even weeks at a time and infrequent use leads to battery discharge. If left uncharged and unmaintained the life of the battery will be shortened. Short journeys, which are common for local groups to make, are also detrimental to a battery's health as there is insufficient time for a full charge. Community groups can easily ensure their vehicles are reliable and ready to transport members by using a smart charger as they present a safe and efficient way of maintaining a battery and prolonging its life. CTEK smart battery chargers are easy to use, do not require any specialist knowledge and can even remain connected for long periods of time without damaging the battery.
