

NY Breast Augmentation Pro Talks Jenny Lee's Surgery Disorder

Prior to performing cosmetic surgery on a patient, the best surgeons go to great lengths to determine if they are a good candidate for surgery.

"Failure to identify a patient's internal struggles could initiate a lifetime of plastic surgery addiction as they continue to seek that one procedure that will make them like themselves," says Dr. Elliot Heller, a [NY breast augmentation](#) specialist. "This is known body dysmorphic disorder."

This seems to be the case with Jenny Lee who insists that all she wants is be

OK with her looks, "just OK."

"Sometimes patients are aware that the root of their body image issues are more than skin-deep, while some are in such a state of denial that they don't display symptoms," says Heller. "A thorough consultation is one of the most important aspects of plastic surgery."

Consultations help give the physician and their patient a clearer understanding of why plastic surgery is sought and a chance to discuss expectations.

"My goal is to improve my patients' well-being, not be the cause of a lifetime of struggle and regret," says Heller who also performs tummy tuck in New York. "Performing surgery on a patient with a mental disorder is no different from giving a recovering alcoholic a beer."
