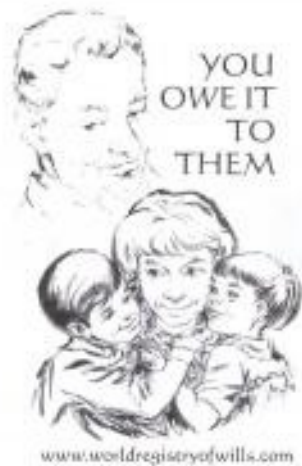

This service helps to address a problem encountered by the legal profession for decades. Bruce Letendre, President of [World Registry Of Wills](#) states that "80% of the world's population do not as yet have a will, and of those that do, more than half cannot be properly executed because they cannot be found when needed." The legal profession continues to urge people to draft a Will and to record its location so that it can be found when required, to avoid countless wasted hours of legal expenses added up while searching for this document, and to minimize the prolonged stressful grieving of family members, friends and business partners.

Letendre is a TYPE 2 diabetes patient of 29 years, and as such has decided to contribute 50% of each registration and search fees to the [Canadian Diabetes Association](#) in support of its efforts to lead the fight against diabetes.

According to the [Canadian Diabetes Association](#), there are approximately a total of 9 million Canadians with diabetes, and who are prediabetic.

In 2008, the International Diabetes Association claimed there were more than 285 million diabetes patients in the worlds, and by 2050, they anticipate that number Will rise to almost 500 million!
